For example, a senior high school student with goals to improve their academic performance and soccer skills in preparation for university and acquire new abilities in their free time.

A learning plan is a type of plan which outlines learning and development measures to be conducted over a specific time frame. In education, a learning plan is usually set by a teacher, a student, or a counselor in order to aid a student in achieving his/her learning goals and targets.

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R – Relevant: If your goal isn ' t relevant to you, you will most likely struggle to see it to completion. A goal needs to hold meaning to your life, whether it ' s a personal goal or a business goal. Setting a relevant, meaningful goal will give you the motivation you need to keep your focus on the main objective.

You can use Bloom's taxonomy to identify verbs to describe participants ' learning. Examples of learning outcomes might include: Knowledge/Remembering: define, list, recognize; Comprehension/Understanding: characterize, describe, explain, identify, locate, recognize, sort; Application/Applying: choose, demonstrate, implement, perform;

A few examples of properly written SMART goals might be helpful here: Research tuition reimbursement and enroll in a degree program before the next employee review period.
